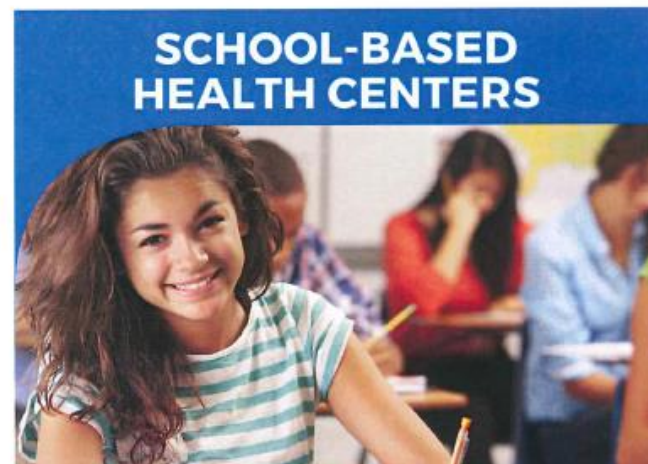

WELCOME TO THE ROGUE WAY TO HEALTH

A School-Based Health Center (SBHC) is a unique health care model for comprehensive physical, mental and preventive health care services for children and adolescents in a school setting. All registered students are eligible for appointments.

CLINIC SERVICES

We welcome everyone. Our priority is to get to know you and your health care needs, then to offer you a wide range of services to meet your wellness goals.

- We offer a full service medical home to meet your primary and preventative health care needs
- Diagnoses and treatment of acute and chronic illness
- Routine physical exams, including sports physicals
- Vision, dental and blood pressure screenings
- Oral health assessments and referral for dental care
- Treatment of minor injuries
- Prescription medications, when indicated
- Immunizations
- Brief mental health screenings and continuous services/counseling
- Health education, counseling and wellness promotion
- Referrals for health care services not provided at school-based health center
- Oregon Health Plan (OHP) enrollment assistance

FUNDING
